Flock Safety is also the sole provider of the comprehensive monitoring, processing, and machine vision services which integrate with the Flock Safety ALPR Camera.

These cameras and devices are the only Law Enforcement Grade ALPR System with all the features and components required by our police department

The Port St. Lucie Police Department is currently using 9 of the ALPR's from Flock Safety. This will be an expansion of that project with the same equipment. Flock Safety is also integrated with Axon, our digital evidence provider (Evidence com).
