The public hearing will be held in the City Council Chambers at 6:00 p.m. on September 23, 2024, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, located at the City of Port St. Lucie Municipal Complex (City Hall-Council Chambers), 121 S.W. Port St. Lucie Blvd., Port St. Lucie, Florida 34984 for receiving public comment on the proposed collection of the assessments. All affected property owners have a right to appear at the hearing and may file written objections with the Council in care of the City Clerk prior to the meeting. Written objections may also be filed with the City Clerk at the hearing any time before the adjournment of the hearing. If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Council with respect to any matter considered at the hearing, such person will need a record of the proceedings and may need to arrange for a court reporter to ensure that a verbatim record is made. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, persons needing special accommodations or an interpreter to participate in this proceeding should contact the City Clerk's office at 772-871-517, at least seven days prior to the date of the hearing. Copies of the assessment roll, showing the amount of the assessment to be imposed against each parcel of property, and the legal documentation relating to the assessment by the available for inspection in 2025 when the assessment is prepared. They can be reviewed in the office of the City Clerk, located on the Third Floor of City Hall, 121 S.W. Port St. Lucie Blvd., Port St. Lucie, Florida. The assessments will be collected on the non-ad valorem portion of the tax bill to be mailed in November 2025 by the St. Lucie County Tax Collector. Failure to pay the assessment will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property, which may result in a loss of title to your property.
