WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept the Special Warranty Deed attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** to obtain the missing pieces.

If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
