SUBJECT: COMMUNITY BLVD – ROAD CLOSURE (RC-220)
BEEP INTEGRATION INTO TRADITION

Please be advised that as part of the BEEP integration into the Tradition Community, Community Boulevard between Discovery Way and Tradition Parkway must be intermittently closed. This intermittent closure will allow for GNSS base installation, trial runs and fine tuning the first planned BEEP route from the Manderlie subdivision to Tradition Town Square. This BEEP route will use Community Boulevard and Meeting Street to travel between the Manderlie subdivision and Tradition Town Square.

Please see the attached Road Closure request (RC-220) for more details on this closure. The planned intermittent closures of Community Boulevard are as follows:

- 8:00 pm to 6:00 am – October 21st to 22nd
- 8:00 pm to 6:00 am – November 4th to 7th
- 7:00 am to 10:00 pm – November 21st

The above dates are intended to have BEEP operational and available to the public in December, date certain yet to be determined.
