ORDINANCE 23-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, FOR THE PARTIAL ABANDONMENT & TERMINATION OF FLOWAGE EASEMENT, RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORD BOOK 2902, PAGE 1177, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to abandon and terminate a portion of Flowage Easement recorded in O.R Book 2902, Page 1177, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, and more particularly described in the attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Ratification of Recitals.</u> The foregoing recital is hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and is hereby made a part of this Ordinance.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the flowage easement described in the attached Exhibit "A" is hereby abandoned and any right, title or interest of the public in and to that portion of the flowage easement on any recorded map or plat is hereby renounced and reclaimed.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The effect of this Ordinance is to abandon a portion of the flowage easement and to renounce or disclaim any right, title or interest of the public in and to said flowage easement.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Recordation. The City Council hereby directs that this Ordinance be recorded in the public records of St. Lucie County, Florida.
- <u>Section 5.</u> <u>Conflict.</u> If any ordinances, or parts of ordinances, are in conflict herewith this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.
- <u>Section 6.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 7.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption on second reading.
