A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") STATE-FUNDED GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSPORTATION REGIONAL INCENTIVE PROGRAM ("TRIP") NECESSARY FOR THE FDOT'S PARTICIPATION IN IMPROVING PORT ST. LUCIE BOULEVARD FROM DARWIN BOULEVARD TO GATLIN BOULEVARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Port St. Lucie Boulevard from Darwin Boulevard to Gatlin Boulevard is owned and maintained by the City of Port St. Lucie ("City"); and

**WHEREAS,** the State of Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") is willing to enter into a grant agreement to provide financial assistance to the City to improve Port St. Lucie Boulevard from Darwin Boulevard to Gatlin Boulevard, identified by the FDOT as FPN #431752-4-54-01 ("Project"), state the terms and conditions upon which FDOT funds will be provided and to set forth the manner in which the Project will be undertaken and completed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project scope consists of improving the existing 4-lane roadway to provide turn lanes, sidewalks, pedestrian lighting, curb and gutter drainage, signing and pavement markings, and lighting and signalization with construction to be completed by December 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the FDOT agrees to participate in the Project cost up to the maximum amount of \$4,269,129.00 and the FDOT's participation in the Project shall not exceed 50% of the total cost of the Project, estimated at \$8,538,258.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the FDOT and the City desire to enter into the State-Funded Grant Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A," pursuant to Section 339.2819, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby determines that the parties may enter into the Agreement as it serves a public purpose,

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1</u>. <u>Ratification of Recitals</u>. The City Council hereby adopts and ratifies those matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.
- <u>Section 2</u>. <u>Authorization</u>. The City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the State-Funded Grant Agreement and any other

documents related to the FDOT roadway widening of Port St. Lucie Boulevard from Darwin Boulevard to Gatlin Boulevard.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to FDOT Office of Comptroller, MS 24 at 605 Suwannee Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399 and State of Florida Auditor General Local Government Audits/342 at 111 West Madison Street, Room 401, Tallahassee, FL 3239, and all other persons as directed by the City Council.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Conflict.</u> If any Resolution, or parts of any Resolution, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is held to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect and this Resolution shall nevertheless stand and be construed as if the illegal or invalid part or portion had not been included herein.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
