A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PUBLIC ART ADVISORY BOARD; APPROVING A TEMPORARY ART INSTALLATION AGREEMENT FOR AMIGO & AMIGO BETWEEN THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Public Art Advisory Board ("PAAB") was established in 2007 with the purpose of promoting public appreciation of the arts; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the importance of arts and culture to an attractive vibrant, healthy, and sustainable community; and

WHEREAS, temporary artistic installations can serve to educate and inspire communities, stimulate local business corridors, increase pedestrian traffic, and engage and transform communities; and

WHEREAS, the Art in Public Places Plan ("AiPP"), created in 2021, contemplates non-construction temporary installations of public art and furthers Goal 7 of the Strategic Plan.

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2023, the PAAB unanimously voted to forward a recommendation of approval to City Council for a temporary art installation entitled Trumpet Flowers ("Proposed Artwork") at the MidFlorida Event Center and enter into an agreement with Amigo & Amigo ("Artist"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a hearing on October 23, 2023, to consider the Proposed Artwork; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Proposed Artwork and all evidence and testimony submitted into the record relating to the Proposed Artwork and has determined that the approval of the Proposed Artwork is consistent with the AiPP.

RESOLUTION 23-R

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Ratification of Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2. Implementation.</u> The City Manager, or his designee, are hereby authorized and directed to proceed to execute the Agreement and take any and all necessary actions to implement the Agreement.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Conflict</u>. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
