AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, REZONING 0.74 ACRES OF PROPERTY, LOCATED AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SW CONANT AVENUE AND SW DOMINA ROAD, FROM SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (RS-2) ZONING DISTRICT TO WAREHOUSE INDUSTRIAL (WI) FOR PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS PORT ST. LUCIE SECTION 31, BLOCK 1711, LOTS 23, 24, AND 25 (P21-083); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Randall Rogers, PE of Velcon Engineering and Surveying, LLC, acting as agent for Orellana Properties, Inc., seeks to rezone of 0.74 acres of property located at the northwest corner of SW Conant Avenue and SW Domina Road, and within the City of Port St. Lucie, from the Single-Family Residential (RS-2) Zoning District to Warehouse Industrial (WI) Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the proposed zoning is consistent with all applicable elements of the City's adopted Comprehensive Plan and complies with the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie Planning and Zoning Board held a public hearing on June 1, 2021 to consider the rezoning application (P21-083), notice of said hearing to adjoining property owners for a radius of seven hundred and fifty (750) feet having been given and advertising of public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on August ___, 2021, to consider the rezoning application (P21-083), advertising of the public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the rezoning application (P21-083) based on substantial and competent evidence and the City Council has determined to rezone the property legally described as Port St. Lucie Section 31, Block 1711, Lots 23, 24, and 25 as recorded in Plat

Book 14, Pages 22, 22A through 22G, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Ratification of Recitals.</u> The City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, hereby adopts and ratifies those matters as set forth in the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. That the property located on the northwest corner of SW Conant Avenue and SW Domina Road, and legally described as Port St. Lucie Section 31, Block 1711, Lots 23, 24, and 25, recorded in Plat Book 14, Pages 22, 22A through 22G, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, be rezoned from Single-Family Residential (RS-2) Zoning District to Warehouse Industrial (WI) Zoning District.

Section 3. Conflict. If any ordinance, or parts of ordinances, or if any sections, or parts of sections, of the ordinances of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are in conflict herewith, this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its final adoption.
