TERMINATION OF DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2007, a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants was executed by Hebert Mingace and Nancy J. Mingace (the "Former Owners") and recorded in Official Records Book 2857, Page 1408, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, encumbering the following described real property, to wit:

WHEREAS, the Current Owners wish to separate Lots 11 and 26 and no longer desire to occupy the Subject Property as one single residential unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie agrees to the Termination of the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants upon payment of the total sum of **Two Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents** (\$200.00), which sum represents the administrative fee for processing the Current Owners' request, there being no outstanding assessments due and owing on the Subject Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of \$200.00, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City of Port St. Lucie hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The City of Port St. Lucie hereby acknowledges receipt of full and complete payment in satisfaction of this Termination of Declaration of Restrictive Covenants.
- 3. The Declaration of Restrictive Covenants recorded in Official Records Book 2857, Page 1408, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, restricting the Subject property to one single residential unit is hereby terminated.
- 4. By this Termination of said Declaration of Restrictive Covenants the lots described herein may each be subject to assessments by the City of Port St. Lucie as separate residential units.
- 5. Lots 11 and 26, Block 780, Port St. Lucie Section Eighteen, may be developed independently of each other in accordance with the rules and regulations of the City of Port St. Lucie.
