

Summary of Proposed 2026 Community Survey Instrument

This document is a shortened version of a survey, now 3.5 pages long, compared to the original full survey which was 5 pages.

Abbreviated Survey

The abbreviated survey asks respondents to rate various aspects of the quality of life in Port St. Lucie, including:

- Port St. Lucie as a place to live
- Your neighborhood as a place to live
- Port St. Lucie as a place to raise children
- Port St. Lucie as a place to work
- Port St. Lucie as a place to retire

Respondents can rate each aspect as Excellent, Good, Fair, Poor, or Don't know, using a scale from 1 to 5.

Full Survey with Revisions

The full survey includes the above questions along with additional questions that were removed in the abbreviated version. The revisions were made to streamline the survey and avoid redundancy by removing questions that were similar to others. It is recommended that any questions removed from the abbreviated survey can be included in future surveys for more comprehensive feedback.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Council finalize the Annual National Community Survey, incorporating the abbreviated survey format. This will ensure the survey remains concise while capturing essential data on the quality of life in Port St. Lucie. Future surveys can include the removed questions to gather more detailed insights as needed.
