A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL COST SHARE AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE ST LUCIE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT AND CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE FOR THE NEW TRAFFIC SIGNAL FACILITY FOR FIRE STATION 20 ON SW VILLAGE PARKWAY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** The City and the Saint Lucie County Fire District have determined that they should enter into an interlocal cost share agreement for the new Traffic Signal Facility for Fire Station 20 on SW Village Parkway as set forth in **Exhibit "A"**.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

- **Section 1.** The City Council hereby adopts and ratifies those matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, or her designee or the City Manager, or his designee, to enter into, execute and deliver the Interlocal Agreement, in substantially the same form that is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", and such other documents necessary to implement the terms of said Agreement.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Manager or his designee, is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the Agreement, and accomplish the purposes set forth within.
- **Section 4.** The City Clerk of the City of Port St. Lucie is hereby directed to send copies of this Resolution to the County and all other necessary parties.
- <u>Section 5.</u> If any resolution, or parts of any resolution, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.
- **Section 6.** The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is held to be invalid or illegal by a Court of competent jurisdiction then the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7.	This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
