A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT FOR VERANDA PLAT NO. 8 WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA UPON THE REQUEST OF VF II, LLC (P21-140); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by Dennis Murphy of Culpepper & Terpening, acting as agent for VF II, LLC, to approve the preliminary and final plat for Veranda Plat No. 8 within the St. Lucie Lands PUD, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and WHEREAS, the plat conforms to Section 156, Port St. Lucie City Code, and meets all State requirements for such plats; and
