

RESOLUTION 20-

A RESOLUTION NAMING THE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY TRACT LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS TRACT R-1, SOUTHERN GROVE PLAT NO. 33, AS DEPICTED ON EXHIBIT “A”, SW ANTHONY F. SANSONE SR BOULEVARD; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie seeks to name the road right-of-way tract legally described as Tract R-1, Southern Grove Plat No. 33, as depicted Exhibit “A”, and within the City of Port St. Lucie, SW Anthony F. Sansone SR Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Tract R-1 as depicted on Southern Grove Plat No. 33 is dedicated to the City of Port St. Lucie for roadway purposes; and

WHEREAS, City Council Directed Policy # 19-04ccd, provides the procedures for the naming of City property and facilities and designates the City Council as having sole discretion in naming City property or facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 12 of City Council Directed Policy # 19-04ccd specifically provides that the City Council shall have the power to waive any and/or all sections of City Council Directed Policy # 19-04ccd; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approves naming the road right-of-way tract legally described as Tract R-1, Southern Grove Plat No. 33, SW Anthony F. Sansone SR Boulevard, and waives the procedures set forth in City Council Directed Policy # 19-04ccd for the naming of City property and facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The road right-of-way legally described as Tract R-1, Southern Grove Plat No. 33, as depicted Exhibit “A”, and within the City of Port St. Lucie, is hereby named SW Anthony F. Sansone SR Boulevard.

Section 3. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If

any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
