

RESOLUTION 25-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, ALLOWING THE EXECUTION OF AND APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH ST. LUCIE COUNTY FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie (“City”) and St. Lucie County (“County”) previously entered into the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement (dated February 11, 2019) concerning the management and disposal of the solid waste that the City collects and delivers to the County’s solid waste management and disposal system (“System”); and

WHEREAS, the County has notified the City that the County does not intend to renew the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement when it expires on September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City and the County wish to revise and clarify their respective obligations, which they intend to accomplish by replacing the existing Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement with the new Interlocal Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** (“New Interlocal Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to deliver its municipally collected solid waste and recyclable materials to the County’s System, and the County is willing to accept the City’s municipally collected solid waste and recyclable materials for processing, recycling, and/or disposal, subject to the terms and conditions in the New Interlocal Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit “A.”**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Implementation. The Mayor, or her designee, or the City Manager, or his designee, are hereby authorized and directed to proceed to execute the New Interlocal Agreement attached as **Exhibit “A”** and take any and all necessary actions and execute all papers and other instruments required for that purpose.

Section 3. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or

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unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
