ORDINANCE 25-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE AMENDING THE RIVERLAND MASTER SIGN PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, adopted a master sign program known as Riverland Master Sign Program with the adoption of Ordinance 17-57; and

WHEREAS, Riverland/GL Homes requested to amend the Riverland Master Sign Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie Planning and Zoning Board held a public hearing on the 6th day of May 2025, to consider the application (P17-097-A1), with advertising of the public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on the 27th day of May 2025, to consider amendment of the Riverland Master Sign Program, with advertising of the public hearing having been made; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that the adoption of the Master Sign Program is authorized by Section 155.03(H), Port St. Lucie City Code, and will not adversely affect the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Ratification of Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made part of this ordinance

Section 2. That the City Council of Port St. Lucie adopts the master sign program for Riverland (P17-097-A1) titled Riverland Master Sign Program, contained in the attached document, Exhibit "A," pursuant to Section 155.03(H), Port St. Lucie Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Conflict</u>. If any ordinance, or parts of ordinances, or if any sections, or parts of sections, of the ordinances of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are in conflict herewith, this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall

remain in full force and effect. Nothing herein shall be deemed to be the City of Port St. Lucie's affirmation that any other part of the Riverland Master Sign Plan does or does not comply with applicable laws.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. That this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after City Council approval.
