

ORDINANCE 26-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, ABANDONING A TWENTY (20) FOOT WIDE DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENT LYING IN TRACT M, PORT ST. LUCIE SECTION THIRTY-THREE, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 15, PAGE 1, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the applicant, Chris Hollen, P.E. on behalf of Morgan CNL Becker LLC, requests approval for the abandonment of a twenty (20) foot wide Drainage and Utility Easement lying in Tract M, Port St. Lucie Section Thirty-Three, according to the plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 15, Page 1, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, and more particularly described in the attached Exhibit “A” which is incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recital is hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and is hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. That the twenty (20) foot wide Drainage and Utility Easement described in Exhibit “A” is hereby abandoned and any right, title, or interest of the public in and to that the twenty (20) foot wide Drainage and Utility Easement on any recorded map or plat is hereby renounced and reclaimed.

Section 3. The effect of this Ordinance is to abandon the above-described Drainage and Utility Easement and to renounce or disclaim any right, title, or interest of the public in and to said easement.

Section 4. Recordation. The City Council hereby directs that this Ordinance be recorded in the public records of St. Lucie County, Florida.

Section 5. Conflict. If any ordinances, or parts of ordinances, are in conflict herewith this Ordinance shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 6. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after final adoption on second reading.
