The purpose of this letter is to request consideration to be reappointed by City Council to the Port St. Lucie Municipal Police Officer's Retirement Trust Fund Board of Trustees. I am a current city resident and have been for almost 43 years. I have synopsised my qualifications in this letter as it pertains to the trustee position.

As a representative of City Council, I have always taken my responsibilities seriously and acted in the best interest of the city and plan membership when making decisions concerning the administration of the pension plan.

I have served on the board of trustees at various times during my career with the police department as both an elected member and also as a City Council appointee, totaling approximately 30 years. I also served as chairman for approximately 14 of those years while a member of the City of Port St Lucie Police Department. I am one of the original pension board members since the plan inception in 1982 and have a wealth of historical knowledge of the plan, in addition to being involved in establishing the systems in place to administer and oversee the plan.

I am a Certified Public Pension Trustee, through the Florida Public Pension Trustee's Association (FPPTA), which required considerable amount of time on my part and expense on the part of the plan to obtain. This certification requires continuing education in order to fulfill the responsibilities as a fiduciary of the plan. I hold two master's degrees, which enhance the knowledge that I bring to the board as a trustee.

Because of the complexities of overseeing an actively managed Defined Benefit Pension Plan there is a considerable amount of knowledge and experience necessary to be an effective member of the Retirement Board of Trustees. With my experience as a trustee, in addition to my knowledge, and education, I can "*hit the ground running*" and continue to contribute to the oversight of the plan.
