TERMINATION OF AMENDED RESTRICTIVE COVENANT

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2005, an Amended Restrictive Covenant executed by Roy L. Lampien and Nancy L. Lampien ("Former Owners") was recorded on May, 30, 1996, in Official Records Book 2192, at Page 891, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, encumbering the following described real property, to wit:

Lots 25 and 26, Block 2114, Port St. Lucie Section Twenty-One, according to the Plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 13, at Pages 27, 27A through 27F, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida (the "Subject Property").

WHEREAS, by said Amended Restrictive Covenant, the Former Owners stated that they occupied the Subject Property as one single residential unit and intended to restrict the Subject Property so that it could be occupied and used only as one single residential unit; and

WHEREAS, the Amended Restrictive Covenant was created for the purpose of combining the Subject Property so the lots would be assessed by the City of Port St. Lucie as a single residential unit for the water/sewer extension project, referred to as USA 5, 6 and 7A MSBU; and

WHEREAS, Samland LLC, a Florida limited liability company, the current owner of the Subject Property, wishes to separate the Subject Property and no longer desires to occupy the Subject Property as one single residential unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie agrees to the Termination of said Amended Restrictive Covenant upon payment of the total sum of **Two Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$200.00)**, which sum represents the total outstanding assessments due and owing on the Subject Property based upon equivalent residential connections (ERC) within the Utility Service assessment area; and

WHEREAS, by the Termination of the Amended Restrictive Covenant, each of the lots identified herein will be subject to assessments by the City of Port St. Lucie as a separate residential unit for the water/sewer extension project, referred to as USA 5, 6 and 7A MSBU.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of **\$200.00**, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City of Port St. Lucie hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

2. The City of Port St. Lucie hereby acknowledges receipt of full and complete payment in satisfaction of the referenced Amended Restrictive Covenant and said Amended Restrictive Covenant is hereby released, satisfied and discharged in its entirety.
3. The Amended Restrictive Covenant recorded in Official Records Book 2192, at Page 891, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, restricting the Subject Property to one single residential unit is hereby terminated.
4. By the Termination of said Amended Restrictive Covenant, the lots described herein shall each be subject to assessments by the City of Port St. Lucie as a separate residential unit for the water/sewer extension project, referred to as USA 5, 6 and 7A MSBU .
5. Lots 25 and 26, Block 2114, Port St. Lucie Section Twenty-One, may be developed independently of each other in accordance with the rules and regulations of the City of Port St. Lucie.
