## RESOLUTION NO. 22-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE PRELIMINARY PLAT AND CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR HERON PRESERVE AT TRADITION PHASE 2B (P21-137) WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, ON THE REQUEST OF PULTE HOME COMPANY, LLC; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by Pulte Home Company, LLC, the owner, to approve and accept the preliminary plat titled Heron Preserve at Tradition Phase 2B, with construction plans, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and

That the City Council hereby approves the preliminary plat and construction plans titled Heron Preserve at Tradition Phase 2B (P21-131) within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, said plat being offered by Pulte Home Company, LLC, the owners, and as prepared by Caulfield and Wheeler, Inc. as designated on the attached said Plat.

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<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Conflict</u>. If any resolution, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 5</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
