

RESOLUTION 22-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS A PORTION OF LOT 33, BLOCK 407, PORT ST. LUCIE SECTION THREE, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 12, PAGE 13, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE FLORESTA DRIVE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FROM SOUTHBEND BOULEVARD TO PRIMA VISTA BOULEVARD AS BEING A PUBLIC NECESSITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO TAKE ANY AND ALL APPROPRIATE ACTIONS TO ACQUIRE THE SUBJECT PROPERTY IN FEE SIMPLE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie’s Public Works Department has recommended the acquisition of real property described as a portion of Lot 33, Block 407, Port St. Lucie Section Three, as recorded in Plat Book 12, Page 13, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, for the construction and installation of additional roadway width to enable U-turn movements for the improvement of Floresta Drive from Southbend Boulevard to Prima Vista Boulevard (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project is in the public interest, for a public purpose, and therefore necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Project is an integral and necessary component of the City’s infrastructure and transportation network and is required to meet the anticipated needs of this growing community; the Project’s 2-lane roadway plan that will improve traffic performance and safety; and the proposed construction and improvements will have minimal environmental and social impacts; and

WHEREAS, after considering the factors set forth above, this City Council has determined that the fee simple acquisition of the subject parcel for the Project is a public necessity and constitutes a public purpose for which public funds may be expended; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, or his designee, are hereby authorized to take any and all appropriate action, including executing and entering into the Vacant Land Contract attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A”, and to accomplish the acquisition of the subject parcel in fee simple on behalf of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Implementation. The City Manager, or his designee, are hereby authorized

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and directed to proceed to take any and all necessary actions, including executing the Vacant Land Contract, for the City of Port St. Lucie to acquire, in its own name, by purchase, the real property described above and execute all papers and other instruments required for that purpose.

Section 3. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
