Public Art Requirements

- All private development meeting the applicability requirements is subject to a public art assessment of one percent of the total dollar amount of a project's total construction costs.
- The public art assessment is capped at \$100,000.
- Section 162.08 of the Code allows a developer to elect one of four assessment methods:
 - 1. on-site artwork;
 - 2. contribution to fund;
 - 3. on-site artwork and contribution to fund; or
 - 4. submittal of an alternative equivalent proposal


