A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE LIMITED ACCESS RIGHT-OF-WAY OF INTERSTATE 95; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie's Public Works Department intends to construct sidewalk improvements along Galiano Road; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Galiano Road underpass is constructed within the right-ofway of Interstate 95; and

WHEREAS, the proposed sidewalk improvements will encroach into State of Florida Department of Transportation Limited Access Right-of-Way of Interstate 95; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 339.282, Florida Statutes, the State of Florida Department of Transportation may contract with a property owner to finance, construct, and improve public transportation facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Ratification of Recitals.</u> The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Implementation</u>. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the Construction Agreement, in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit "A," on behalf of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, to allow construction of sidewalk improvements within the Limited Access Right-of-way of Interstate 95.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Conflict</u>. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
