In order to not add more work to staff and to keep online payment processing simple and secure for utility customers it is imperative that the Utility System's billing software and online platforms are fully integrated and Real-time capabilities.

Letter from Original Equipment Manufacturer (required):

Exclusive Capability

Provide a detailed description of proposed source's unique capabilities and/or personnel to perform the work and why this is the only source.

Invoice Cloud and our current credit card processor Paymentus Corporation are the only online platforms that are fully integrated with the Utility's current billing software, AUS.

IC cloud offers Apple pay and Google pay which Paymentus does not offer at this time. Note, there are no fees for us when customer use either of these 2 options. IC also offers Venmo and Paypal, Paymentus has these options as well but only Paypal has been rolled out to us and it's only available to unregistered users. We currently have 11,000 unregistered users and 38,000 registered users. So we are missing a large customer population for these features. We want our customers to be registered users because it gives them access to auto pay, saved payment methods, viewing of bills, and e-billing.

IC already has a "round up" program that can be configured. We are supposed to implement a program like this that would go towards a septic to sewer fund as suggested by CM and Council office. We advised we would work towards it after CIS V4 went live. Paymentus does not offer this at this time, so it would be another hurdle when we are ready for that program to be implemented.

Another big advantage IC has over Paymentus is that IC offers the ability for the reps to "access" the customer's online portal just like the customer can so it will help them be able to walk customers through issues or problems they may be facing or not understanding.

Last big difference we could be looking at is that Paymentus only validates bank routing numbers for echecks, not account #'s. Which means the customer can put in a fake, closed, or accidently put in the wrong bank account # but Paymentus does not do any account # validations before they accept the payment. Invoice Cloud does a "soft hit" validation to determine if the account # is valid, open and not excessively over with drawn before they accept the payment.
