A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT FOR SOUTHERN GROVE PLAT NO. 34 WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF PORT ST LUCIE GOVERNMENTAL FINANCE CORPORATION (P20-216); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
