SOLID WASTE TASK FORCE

The City of Port St. Lucie values the opinions of City residents and business owners and encourages their input. The purpose of the Solid Waste Task Force (SWTF) is to act in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters of solid waste collection and recycling. In this capacity, the SWTF shall review, comment and/or make recommendations to the Solid Waste Division on matters of performance and collection practices under the current Franchise Agreement; review possible short-term contract modifications and other remedial measures; and analyze future collection methodologies in planning for the next Request for Proposal (RFP).

The City of Port St. Lucie is currently seeking individuals for the Solid Waste Task Force. In addition to nine (9) regular members, there will be two (2) alternate members. Appointments will be made by the Mayor, with advice and consent of the City Council, as required by the City Charter. One councilmember will be appointed as a non-voting liaison to the SWTF.

Individuals with current or recent experience working in the solid waste or recycling field are strongly encouraged to apply. Other relevant experience which is highly desired includes logistics, operations, transportation, or real estate. Every effort will be made to have members representing each of the City's 4 Council Districts.

Qualified candidates serve on a voluntary basis, must be City residents, and are subject to the Sunshine Law (s.286.011, F.S.). The Committee's meeting dates and times are yet to be determined. Applicants are required to submit a brief resume, along with their application. Applications are available online at www.cityofpsl.com.
