A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT FOR SOUTHERN GROVE PLAT NO. 28 WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF BARON SHOPPES TRADITION, LLC (P20-006); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, has been requested by Engineering, Design, and Construction, Inc., acting as agent for Baron Shoppes Tradition, LLC, to approve the preliminary and final plat for Southern Grove Plat No. 28, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and
