RE: Abandonment of Easement

Motion to Adopt Ordinance 25-, Abandoning a Portion of a Twenty (20) foot wide rear Utility and Drainage Easement affecting Lot 14, Block 2682, Port St. Lucie Section Thirty-Nine, as recorded in Plat Book 15, Pages 30, 30A through 30NN, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida.

The enclosed Ordinance has been reviewed and revised by the City Attorney's Office with respect to the request for an abandonment of a portion of a twenty (20) foot wide rear Utility and Drainage Easement affecting Lot 14, Block 2682, Port St. Lucie Section Thirty-Nine, as Recorded in Plat Book 15, Page 30, 30A through 30NN, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida. The owner has submitted the Abandonment of Easement Application.

The request for the abandonment of a portion of a twenty (20) foot wide rear Utility and Drainage Easement affecting the subject property and all supporting documentation have been reviewed and approved as to legal form and sufficiency. As such, the attached Ordinance has been prepared for presentment to the City Council for review and approval.

This office has confirmed that the survey and legal description associated with the Abandonment of Easement Application has been reviewed and approved by the Public Works Department, the Utility Department, and certain Utility Companies. Upon information and belief, the request for the abandonment of the above-described utility easement has been reviewed and recommended for approval by the Public Works Department and the Utility Systems Department. The agenda item shall be prepared and presented to the City Council by the Public Works Department.
