

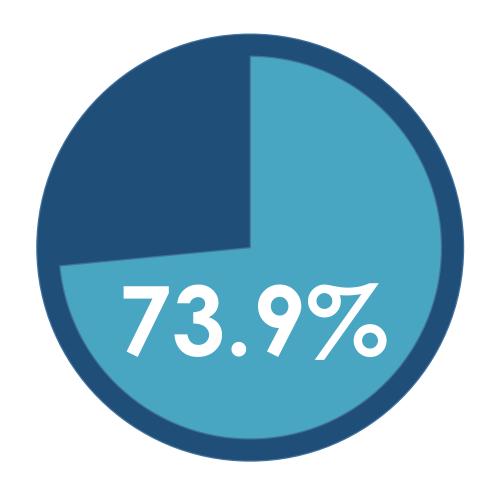

Census Campaign Accomplishments

- Coordinated with Census office weekly
- Proclamation
- Computers made available to the public to fill out Census
- Developed and managed a new census webpage







Developed a Census Contest & Video

- Developed a local photo contest for those that filled out the Census
- Produced an in-house video for the census contest
- In 28 weeks the City had a total of 100 winners with 632 residents entering the contest.

- Designed 30 in-house social media graphics, created especially for local issues such as COVID-19, supporting local businesses, thanking first responders, 30-day countdown, etc.
- Developed a "Census Translates into Dollars" flyer and made corresponding social media posts based on projects that were or will be paid for by federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grants Program. (Received a lot of engagement on these posts and positive feedback)

- Contest video aired for six months
- Announced the importance of the census on The Agenda
- Recorded and set up an on-hold message on City phones that played for four months.

\$1,600.





- Reached over 400K people with our e-blast
- Distributed 15,000 flyers
- Placed pull-up banners throughout City lobby areas
- Yard signs strategically displayed throughout the City
- Displayed A-frame boards at City locations and low-response areas
- Utility inserts
- Published census column in iCARE Community magazine
- Distribute hanging banners at City locations



Public meetings:

- Coffee with the Mayor: Census pull-up banner prominently displayed along with a Mayor's message, and the Mayor interviewed Robin Cryer
- TV-20 slides during City Council meetings that read, "While you wait, take the census"
- Recorded two census radio public service announcements in three languages, English, Spanish and Creole, and shared it with our local radio stations.
- Various departments asked their customers if they had taken the Census.







Low-response areas:

- Neighborhood Services went door-to-door
- Neighborhood Services placed temporary signs
- Emailed/called the property managers in low-response complexes
- Letter from the Mayor sent a letter to lowresponse areas
- The Saints Golf Course's display board read, "Use your Senses. Fill out your census."
- Public Work's Veritable Message Boards (VMB)
