Please accept this email as our objection to approval of the site plan by the City Council; and we urge the Council not to approve it.

We have several reasons -- increased vehicular traffic and congestion, increased traffic and

construction site noise, unsightly refuse, noise generated by the school on a daily basis and the simple fact that a school is not in keeping with the residential character of the neighborhood.
