A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT FOR RIVERLAND CENTER WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF GL HOMES, LLC (P23-024); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
