

eBid #20230049: Swale Liner Maintenance Area A and B

<u>Overview</u>

Swale Liner Maintenace for the City of Port St Lucie will be directly overseen by United Land Services Account Manager, Daniel Washboring (See Attached Resume). Daniel will work directly with staff from the City of Port St Lucie to ensure maintenance of the swale liner is completed to the highest standard.

Operating Management Plan

United Land Services maintain the swale liner in Port St Lucie using multiple crews. The total number of employees on this project will vary based on the season and location. On average there will be between 15-25 crew members, this includes multiple projection manager and an account manager. These crew will use multiple hand tools to edge along the swale liners and clean out any debris that may be contained within the swales. Upon completion of any maintenance, United Land Services Crews will remove any litter or debris from roadways, private residences, and swales before moving to the next location.

Transition Plan

Following the award of the contract, United Land Services will schedule a meeting with project managers from the City of Port St Lucie to schedule a ride along. The purpose of this ride alone will be to review all areas of work with the city. During this ride along the account manager from United Land Services will identify any specific needs for this project that were not listed in the scope of services. United Land Services will designate all equipment and personnel for this project a minimum of one month before initial service.

Schedule

United Land Services will work directly with The City of Port St Lucie to formulate a schedule for when the best time is to complete services. Initial service for swale liner area A in section 20 and will begin service in swale liner area B in section 47. 
