



Questions:

1. **Question:** With all the driveways being so close together I don't see how the job can be completed in 120 days. It will most likely take 180 days to install all the pipe and demo the driveways. Could the City extend the time to 180 days?

Response: The specified 120-day schedule is based on production rates established on City projects with similar scopes and constraints.

2. **Question:** The 10.65% DBE is a goal and not a requirement?

Response: This is a FDOT goal. Contractors are encouraged to utilize DBE's whenever possible to meet the FDOT goal.

3. **Question:** Is there a hyperlink to the approved DBE vendors registered with the City of Port St. Lucie?

Response: The City does not register DBE's. As noted on Page 3 of 71 of the E-Bid documents, "Use DBEs that are certified under the Florida Unified Certification Program Directory: <http://www.bipincwebapps.com/biznetflorida/>"

4. **Question:** Is there an approved laydown/staging yard for contractor's materials and equipment that will not require additional MOT restrictions or within the project limits?

Response: A parcel is available on Marion just east of Curtis.



5. **Question:** Scheduling of driveway demo and reconstruction is consecutive to work progressing forward from "Begin Project" point or will contractor be required to work around each resident's "Personal" schedule (understanding of daily replacement to near existing for access upon excavation) or will this be a requirement of the City's representative to discuss and relay construction expectations with residents? This will have an impact upon concrete scheduling, construction joints, material cost increase, etc.?

Response: The contractor is required to provide a 5-day notice to the owners of the scheduled demolition. The contractor will need to confirm the swale area is stabilized to ensure the owners have a place to park. No driveway is to be inaccessible over weekends or holidays.

6. **Question:** 24" RCP is identified on the plans but not listed on the bid schedule. Can this be updated to reflect the 24"?

Response: Yes, 4' of 24" RCP will be added. (Pay item 430-175-124). The E-Bid Reply Excel Spreadsheet will be issued as Addendum #2. This will be the only form accepted unless directed in a future Addendum. No exceptions will be made.

7. **Question:** No line item is listed for concrete collar for dissimilar pipe. Which line item is this to be included under?

Response: Sheet 3, pay item note for 430-175-215 includes the concrete jacket for connecting dissimilar pipes. Per FDOT Standard Specification 430-12 no separate payment will be made for concrete collars.

8. **Question:** Can you provide the areas of the driveways where the proposed pipe will not have enough cover and may need to use the reduced cover detail?

Response: The cross sections include sections at every driveway. On the cross sections every driveway is indicated as needing to use the reduced cover detail.

9. **Question:** Can there be a separate line item for the 4" concrete with thickened edge instead of all inclusive in one line item?

Response: No, as specified on sheet 3 under the pay item notes, thickened edge sidewalk is included in pay item 522-1.

10. **Question:** Can there be a separate line item for the 6" concrete with thickened edge instead of all inclusive in one line item?

Response: No, as specified on sheet 3 under the pay item notes, thickened edge sidewalk is included in pay item 522-2.

11. **Question:** The existing pipe located at approximately STA:20+25.00, is it to be removed or remain?

Response: The grass driveway with culvert is to remain.

12. **Question:** Trees that fall in conflict with the sidewalk or within the ROW, are they to be moved or completely removed and if removed will they need to be replaced?

Response: Contractor to work around large trees when possible, small trees will be removed and not replaced.

13. **Question:** Water meters that fall within the footprint of the sidewalk must be moved outside the sidewalk area, or can they be cast in place to finish grade? If the existing meter boxes are damaged who is responsible for their replacement?

If there needs to be additional piping or alterations to the meter and/or service line, who is responsible?

Response: Water meters are to be relocated to the property line behind the sidewalk and will not be in the sidewalk. PSLUSD will relocate the water meters, however, the contractor is responsible for coordinating with PSLUSD to relocate the meters in advance of construction progress.

14. **Question:** Will removal of existing striping by grinding be acceptable?

Response: Considering the age of the asphalt, grinding should be acceptable as long as it does not result in a tripping hazard.

15. **Question:** STA: 29+69.96 calls for the installation of a "New" Type D structure along with 4' of 24" RCP, yet there is an existing structure at this location that is not called out in the plans. Is the existing structure to be removed and the new piping and structure added?

Response: Yes, existing structure is to be removed in order to install new structure and piping. Removal of the existing structure is included under Clearing and Grubbing as defined in the FDOT Standard Specification.

16. **Question:** There is a pedestal light at STA: 32+14 that falls within the sidewalk area, is it to be removed, and if so by whom & will it be required to be relocated?

Response: The contractor in coordination with the CEI will notify the owner of the encroachment and that it needs to be removed/relocated. If the owner does not remove, the contractor will remove and return to the owner using caution not to damage.

17. **Question:** There are several masonry columns in the ROW/Sidewalk area that will have to be removed. Who is responsible and will they have to be replaced?

Response: The contractor in coordination with the CEI will notify the owner of the encroachment and that it needs to be removed/relocated. If the owner does not remove, the contractor will remove and return to the owner using caution not to damage or the contractor may be directed to dispose.
