## **RESOLUTION NO. 22-**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE FINAL PLAT AND CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR SEVILLE PHASE 1 (WG6A) WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES (P21-240); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by Kimley-Horn and Associates, acting as agent for Mattamy Palm Beach, LLC, the owner and developer, to approve the final plat and construction plans for Seville Phase 1, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, there are private roads and drainage facilities to be constructed within the platted area by the developer; and

**WHEREAS**, a performance guarantee covering the cost of the improvements has been submitted to the City: and

**WHEREAS**, the plat conforms to Section 156, Port St. Lucie City Code, and meets all State requirements for such plats; and

**WHEREAS**, The Site Plan Review Committee, on February 24, 2022, recommended approval of the final plat and construction plans (P21-240).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Port St. Lucie as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City hereby adopts and ratifies those matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. That the City Council hereby approves the final plat and construction plans for Seville Phase 1, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, said final plat being offered by Mattamy Palm Beach, LLC as owner and title holder of said property and as prepared by Caulfield and Wheeler, Inc., as designated on the attached said Plat.

Section 3. That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are hereby authorized to countersign the said plat so it may be properly recorded in the public records of St. Lucie County, Florida.

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<u>Section 4</u>. If any Resolution, or parts of any Resolution, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 5. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is held to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect and this Resolution shall nevertheless stand and be construed as if the illegal or invalid part or portion had not been included herein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
