Meighan Beckett, KPSLB Program Manager, informed the Committee that she had two active grants. She gave an update on the cigarette ashtrays and stated that the Keep America Beautiful/Coca Cola grant would be used to purchase child sized grabbers & vests.

7. Unfinished Business

Mr. Cerami proposed that the Committee volunteer for PSLinLights and other City-sponsored events. The Committee and staff discussed the possible need for members to undergo background checks and discussed the difference between volunteering directly with children and volunteering at an event that children may attend. Mr. Cerami also advised the Committee and staff of an issue at PSLinLights involving residents reopening the gate after closing hours. He suggested using electronic locks and KeAndrea Davis, Deputy City Attorney, suggested that the Police Department have a Police Officer stationed at the gate near closing time. Ms. Beckett advised the Committee that she would coordinate with Parks & Recreation staff to identify a solution for the gate keys.

Ms. Beckett discussed the paint flyer that was handed out. Ms. Johnson inquired if it was attached to email blasts, to which Ms. Yunas replied that she would attach the flyer to the City Council email blasts as well as the new resident guide. Ms. Johnson suggested handing it out to Home Depot/Lowes as well as real estate agents.
