A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE FINAL SUBDIVISION PLAT AND CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR VERANO, PUD NO. 1, PLAT NO. 22 WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF VERANO DEVELOPMENT, LLC OF FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by the owners, Verano Development, LLC, to approve and accept the final subdivision plat and construction plans titled Verano, PUD No. 1, Plat No.22, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, there are private improvements, i.e., roads, drainage, and utility facilities, to be constructed within the platted area by the developer; and

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. That the City Council hereby approves the final subdivision plat titled Verano, PUD No. 1, Plat No.22 (P20-082) with construction plans, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, said final plat being offered by Verano Development, LLC, as the owners and title holders of said property and as prepared by Perry C. White, as designated on the attached said Plat.

<u>Section 3</u>. That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida, are hereby authorized to countersign the said plat so it may be properly recorded in the public records of St. Lucie County, Florida.
