Systemic racism and a need for improved equity have become increasingly apparent this year. I hope this need will be included in the 5 year plan and efforts made to create change. With the growing aging population and the need to allow lower income residents to age in place, funding is critical for home accessibility retrofits, home food delivery, access to affordable healthy foods, transportation assistance, creation of safe spaces for physical activity and social interaction, accessory dwelling units, as well as support (including respite) for caregivers who are often working 24/7 to keep family members safe and having a quality life in their later years. For lower income older adults, financial planning and help navigating the federal benefit programs is also a need. The overall health of residents is impacted by access to healthy food options and physical activity. Making PSL a more walkable community is an important part of supporting this effort.
