

RESOLUTION 22-R__

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A CITY TREASURER OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA; SETTING FORTH DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article X, Section 10.01(c), of the Port St. Lucie City Charter, the Manager shall appoint a City Treasurer with the approval of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer shall supervise the collection of all taxes, license fees, and all other monies to which the City may be entitled, and shall maintain accurate records, deposit all monies of the City as provided in Section 9.07 of the Port St. Lucie City Charter, and authorize the expenditures of City funds upon proper warrant. The City Treasurer may invest sinking funds in such securities as may be directed by the City Council and authorized by law. In addition, the City Treasurer shall be responsible for such other duties as are established by any ordinance or resolution of the City of Port St. Lucie; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has appointed Stephen Okiye as City Treasurer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Appointment of City Treasurer. Pursuant to Section 10.01(c), Port St. Lucie City Charter, the City Council hereby approves the City Manager's appointment of Stephen Okiye as City Treasurer.

Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities of City Treasurer. Pursuant to Section 10.01(c), Port St. Lucie City Charter, the City Treasurer shall supervise the collection of all taxes, license fees, and all other monies to which the City may be entitled. The City Treasurer shall maintain accurate records, deposit all monies of the City as provided in Section 9.07 of the Port St. Lucie City Charter, and authorize the expenditure of City funds upon proper warrant. The City Treasurer may invest sinking funds in such securities as may be directed by the City Council and authorized by law.

Section 4. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

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Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
