RE: Port St. Lucie – Pedestrian Bridge at Rivergate Canal Proposal_Rev.1

Dear Mr. Keen,

We are pleased to submit our proposal for the abovementioned project for your review and consideration. The development of this proposal was based on the bidding documents provided via email from Frank Knott on December 15th, 2023, titled "Setting Pedestrian Bridge across Rivergate Canal".

ASSUMPTIONS & INCLUSIONS:

- Mobilization, construction start date, and performance period shall be mutually agreed upon prior to contract execution.
- Owner shall provide adequate working room and laydown space as needed for materials, construction equipment, and temporary facilities.
- One (1) mobilization and one (1) demobilization will be required for our work scopes with uninterrupted access to the site.
- Anchor bolts assumed to be post-installed Hilti HIT-RE epoxy chemical anchors.
- We estimate the construction schedule will be approximately <u>7 weeks</u> as shown in our CPM Schedule found in Attachment B.
- Total bridge lifting weight, excluding rigging and accessories, is understood to be <u>41,204 lbs</u> according to the bill of
 materials shown on Steadfast Bridges design drawing 052208. This design drawing is correlated to the serial number
 on the bridge name plate which bears the same numerals as the respective drawing.
- Management of Traffic is based on the closure of the right-hand Southbound Lane of SE Veterans Memorial Parkway
 for the duration of works. The cost assigned to Item No. 102-1 (Management of Traffic), within Bid sheet found in
 Attachment A, is to be treated as a provisional sum until BCI receives authorization to allocate resources for an ATTSA
 Certified MOT Plan.
- Schedule is dependent on crew, equipment and material availability to be confirmed upon project award. Given our present allocation of resources, the project is unlikely to commence before mid-April 2024.
- Acceptance of proposal shall be contingent on mutually agreeable contract terms and conditions.
- BCI's Proposal must be named as a Contract document, and it shall be clear that its conditions take precedence over other bidding documents, due to the fact that its terms could be more defined or stringent.

GENERAL EXCLUSIONS:

- Any activities related to test piling whether in supportive roles or direct participation.
- Removal and disposal and contaminated materials, and testing costs for such materials.
- Demolition or removal of unquantifiable debris shall be per mutually agreeable T&M basis.
- Subsurface and in-water obstructions for pilings, dredging, or underground utilities shall be on a mutually agreeable T&M basis.



- Costs for onsite third-party pile installation recording and observation.
- Modifications to cost due to permits issued by federal, state, or local governing agencies, not currently in our possession.
- Existing utility obstructions, modifications, repairs, relocation, decommission, or delay due to their presence.
- Permit fees are to be in the Owner's account. BCI will assist in the local permit acquisition process.
- Project design engineering.
- Liability for damage to existing structures unless it is a result of negligent acts.
- Reinstatement of trees removed to gain access to work areas, namely the two palm trees closest to the road on the North bank of the project site.
- Builder's Risk Insurance.









