

# The Port District – Reconfigured Boat Trailer Parking at Veterans Park at Rivergate Boat Ramp

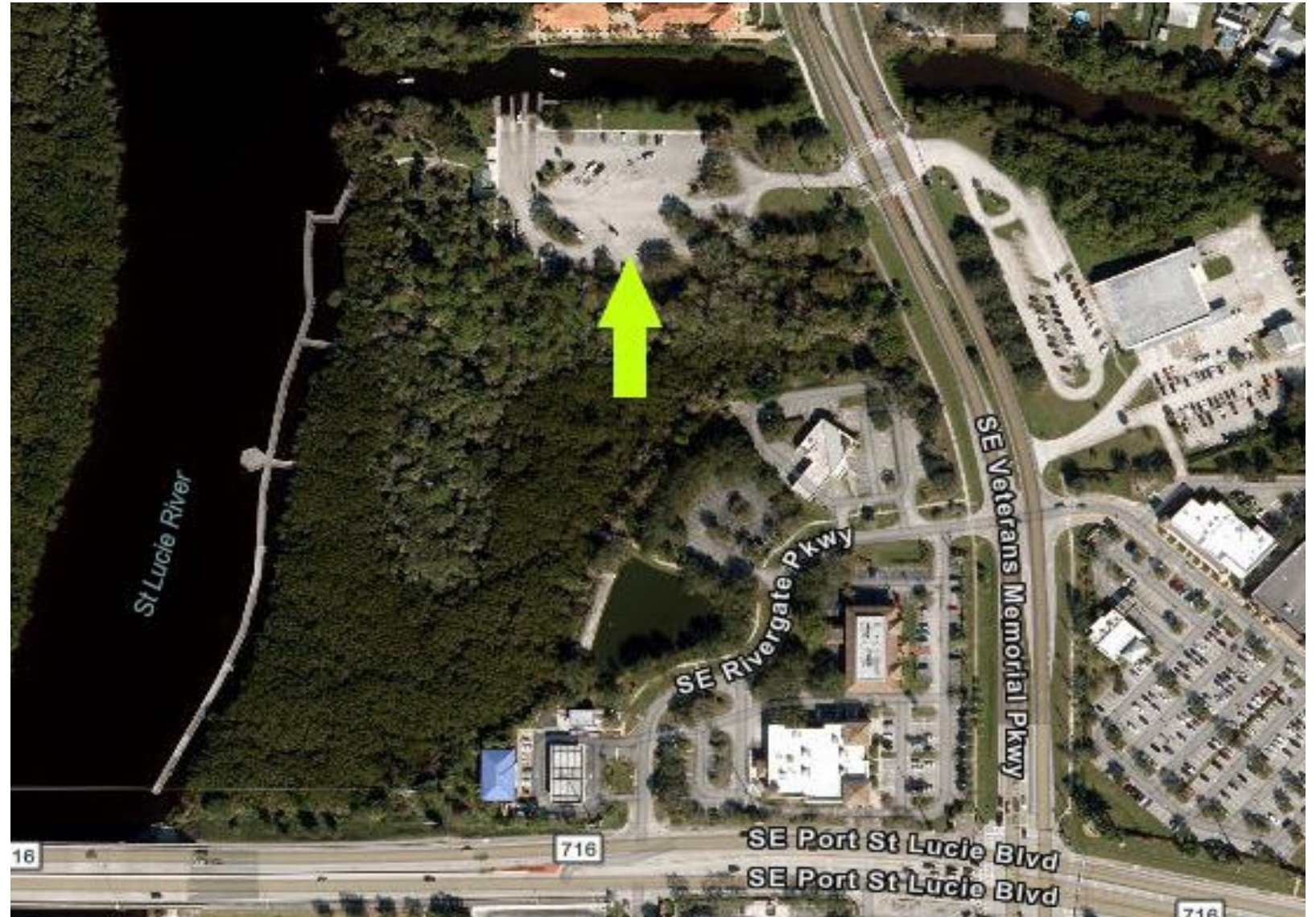

The Port St Lucie Community Redevelopment Agency and Parks and Recreation Department are proposing a reconfiguration of the parking lot at Veterans Park at Rivergate Boat Ramp to increase access to the St. Lucie River.

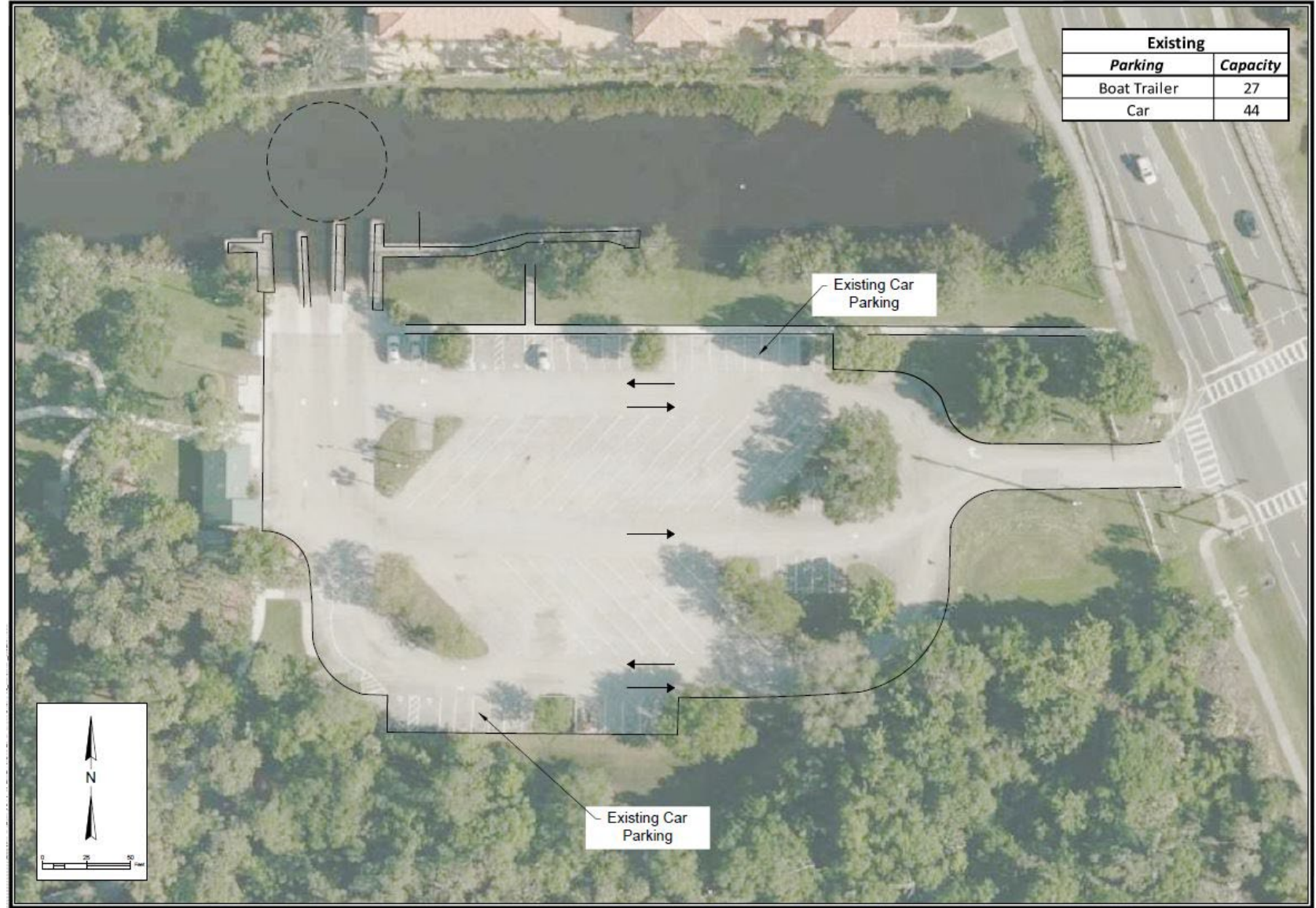
The Veterans Park at Rivergate Boat Ramp is located just north of SE Port St. Lucie Blvd and just west of SE Veterans Memorial Parkway. It provides direct access to the St. Lucie River.



Veterans Park at Rivergate Boat Ramp is the only 24-hour boat ramp within the city limits. Increasing the parking capacity would allow users increased access, particularly during high usage times such as holidays.



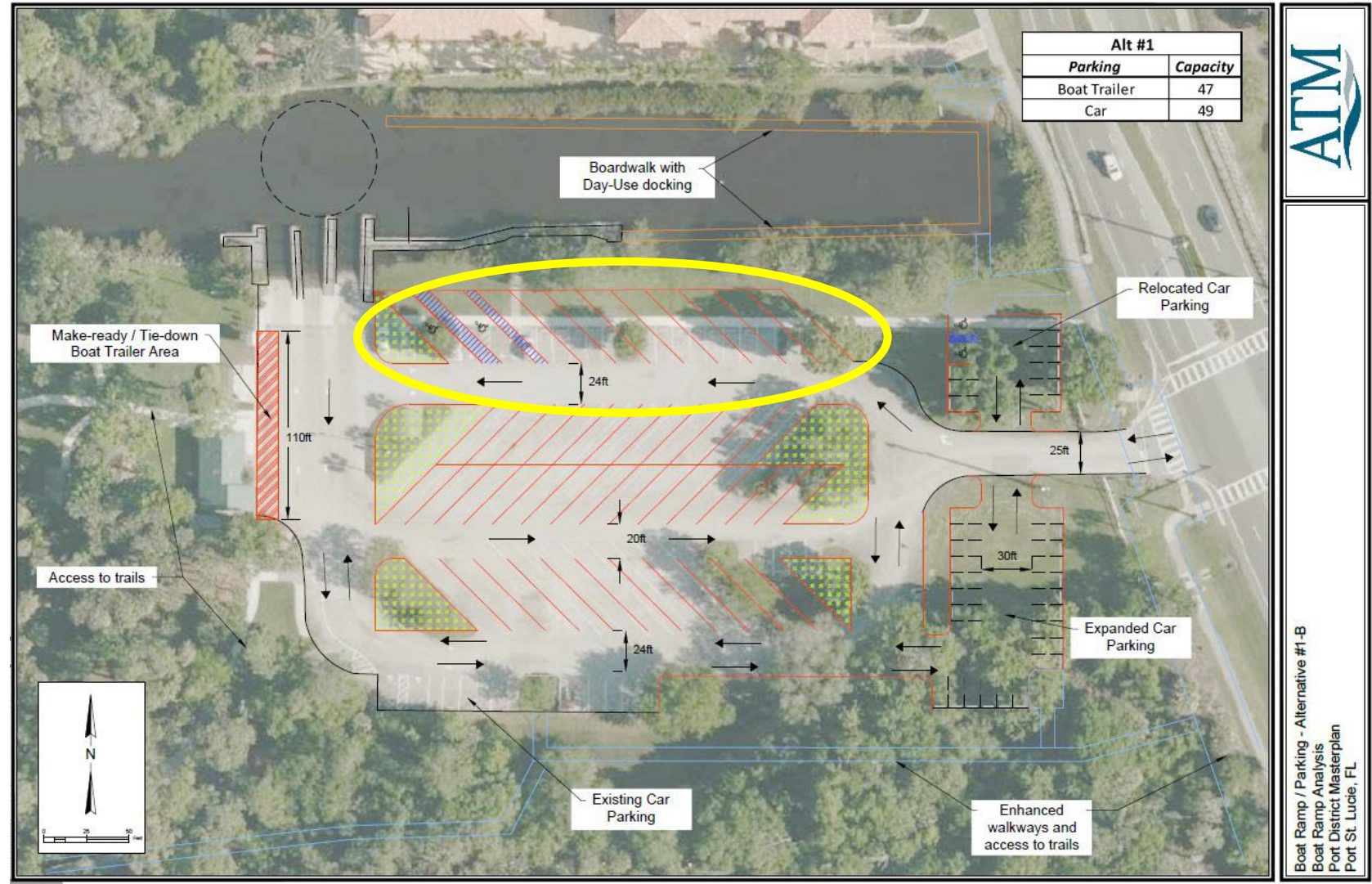
Currently there are 27 boat trailer parking spaces and 44 car parking spaces.

FIND has provided funding for projects within the Port District to assist with overall connectivity to the North Fork of the St. Lucie River.

- FY 2017/18 - \$69,702 for Riverwalk Boardwalk Part 1 Construction
- FY 2018/19 - \$400,000 for Riverwalk Boardwalk Extension Part 2
- FY 2019/20 - \$400,000 for Riverwalk Park Boardwalk Extension Phase IIa
- FY 2020/21 - \$36,000 for Rivergate Canal Boat Ramp Dredging Phase I
- FY 2021/22 - \$235,850 for Boardwalk Under Port St. Lucie Blvd Bridge Phase IIb
- FY 2022/23 - \$225,100 for Boardwalk Under Port St. Lucie Blvd Bridge Phase IIb – Part2
- FY 2023/24 - \$400,000 for Upland Trails-River Boardwalk South Connection Phase I
