TERMINATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANT

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2001, a Restrictive Covenant was executed by Geralyn F. Venables (the "Former Owner") and subsequently recorded on November 26, 2001, in Official Records Book 1458, Page 1464, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, encumbering the following described real property:

Lots 1 and 2, Block 1334, Port St. Lucie Section Eleven, according to the Plat thereof, as recorded in Plat Book 12, Pages 51, 51A through 51E, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida (the "Subject Property").

WHEREAS, by said Restrictive Covenant, the Former Owner stated that she occupied the Subject Property as one single residential unit and intended to restrict the Subject Property so that it can be occupied and used only as one single residential unit; and

WHEREAS, the Restrictive Covenant was created for the purpose of combining the properties so they would be assessed by the City of Port St. Lucie as a single residential unit for the water/sewer extension project, referred to as PS56, Utility Service Area 5, 6, and 7A; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2023, via a Certificate of Title recorded on April 13, 2023, in Official Records Book 4975, Page 393 of St. Lucie County, Florida, M.J.T. Holdings, Inc., a Florida corporation, (the "Owner") obtained title to the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Owner wishes to separate the Subject Property and no longer desires to occupy the Subject Property as one single residential unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie agrees to the Termination of said Restrictive Covenant, upon payment of the total sum of **Two Hundred Dollars** (\$200.00), which sum represents the total outstanding assessments due and owing on the Subject Property based upon equivalent residential connections (ERC) within the Utility Service assessment area; and

WHEREAS, by the Termination of the Restrictive Covenant, each of the lots identified herein will be subject to assessment by the City of Port St. Lucie as a separate residential unit for the water/sewer extension project, referred to as PS56, Utility Service Area 5, 6, and 7A.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of \$200.00, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City of Port St. Lucie hereby covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The City of Port St. Lucie hereby acknowledges receipt of full and complete payment in satisfaction of the referenced Restrictive Covenant and said Restrictive Covenant is hereby released, satisfied, and discharged in its entirety.
- 3. The Restrictive Covenant recorded in Official Records Book 1458, Page 1464, of the Public Records of St. Lucie County, Florida, restricting the Subject Property to one single residential unit is hereby terminated.
- 4. By the Termination of said Restrictive Covenant, the lots described herein, may each be subject to assessment by the City of Port St. Lucie as a separate residential unit.
- 5. Lots 1 and 2, Block 1334, Port St. Lucie Section Eleven, may be developed independently of each other in accordance with the rules and regulations of the City of Port St. Lucie.
