Dr. Eugene G. Savage (Profile)

Dr. Eugene G. Savage served as a law enforcement professional for 37 years. On February 24, 1997, he was appointed chief of police for the Fort Pierce (Florida) Police Department, becoming the first African-American to head the police department in its 96-year history, retiring in 2007 after 10 years of service.

Dr. Savage began his professional career in law enforcement October 5, 1970 as a patrol officer with the West Palm Beach (Florida) Police Department, after completing a tour in the U.S. Army, which included meritorious service in the Vietnam War. He served in all operational and administrative theaters of the police department, working up through the ranks to become its first Black police captain. Additionally, he established their first community-oriented policing program (COP) and served as the assistant chief for 5 years.

During his police career, Dr. Savage pursued his academic goals, earning a Master of Public Administration Degree from Florida Atlantic University (Fort Lauderdale, Florida) in 1990. He studied for a Ph.D. at Florida Atlantic University, finishing his studies and graduating with distinction from Lynn University (Boca Raton, Florida) with a Ph.D. in Global Education, November 2003. Following his graduation, he also served as adjunct professor at his alma mater, Florida Atlantic University. He is a graduate of the72nd Administrative Officers Course, Southern Police Institute at the University of Louisville, graduate of the Chief Executive Seminar a graduate of the John F. Kennedy School of Government @ Harvard University, and also the recipient of a host of awards, honors and commendations.

He has presented Community Oriented Policing issues and other law enforcement topics at many conferences. He coauthored a community-policing study entitled, "Citizen Perception of Community Policing Impact." *Public Administration Quarterly.* The Pennsylvania State University @ Harrisburg, December 1995, 20. Dr. Savage completed his dissertation at Lynn University, "Examining the Post September 11, 2001 Practices of Accredited and Non-accredited Law Enforcement Agencies in the Aspects of Training, Legal and Service Delivery" and it is currently available at UMI.

He has chaired and served on many boards and committees, among them were Past-President of the Minority Law Enforcement Council (MLEC) Past Sector Vice President of the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives (NOBLE), member of the FAU chapter of Phi-Alpha-Alpha, member of the National Forum for Black Public Administrators (NFBPA), and a host of other community and professional organizations. In 2008, he established M-G Consulting Service and has provided training for law

enforcement personnel, and guidance and tutoring for youth, including guiding young Black males on how to react during encounters with law enforcement, through a 10 step-program entitled, Surviving the Stop. Currently, he is the church administrator for Christ Family Worship Assembly, West Palm Beach, Florida.

It is certain that the motivation for much of the preceding can be attributed to a belief in God; and the love, support and encouragement of a strong family support group.
