## **RESOLUTION NO. 21-**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE PRELIMINARY PLAT WITH CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR CADENCE, WITHIN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA ON THE REQUEST OF KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES (P20-174); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida has been requested by Kimley Horn and Associates, acting as agent for the Mattamy Palm Beach, LLC, and the City of Port St. Lucie to approve a preliminary subdivision plat with construction plans for Cadence, within the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida; and
