## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ST. LUCIE COUNTY LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY PLAN

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of St. Lucie County, Florida, has made the following determinations:

- The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2K) requires that all communities, tribes, and states have a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved hazard mitigation plan, consistent with the DMA2K requirements, to retain eligibility for FEMA hazard mitigation grant funding.
- 2. A Florida Department of Emergency Management (FDEM) approved hazard mitigation plan is required for the purpose of certifying compliance with the requirements of the National Flood Insurance Rate Program.
- 3. On August 4, 2021, FDEM found the St. Lucie County Local Mitigation Strategy Plan compliant with federal standards subject to formal adoption.
