

Sundance PSL Master Sign Program Application



<u>Summary</u>

This is a request to create a master sign program for Sundance Port St. Lucie. The master sign program allows the project to customize their signage to meet the needs of the development.

Proposed MSP Signs

Community Monument Entry

Maximum of 6 Large 300SF signs for the perimeter of the DRI.

Residential Monument Entry

Signs for the main entrances of each subdivision or pod of the DRI. Proposes up to 3 signs at 150SF each for each entrance.

Neighborhood Entry

1 sign at entrances of each neighborhood and a maximum of 12 signs within each subdivision. Each may be 50SF maximum.

Wayfinding Signs

60 signs along ROWs providing direction to specific parts of the DRI at 64SF.

The City Sign Code does not include this type of signage.

City Sign Code Regulations

Subdivision Entrance

Signs for the main entrances of a subdivision over 3 acres. Permits either 2 signs at 16SF each or 1 at 32SF.

Neighborhood ID Signs

2 signs at each entrance at 16SF each or 1 at 32SF.

The City Sign Code does not include this type of signage. The only comparison is small 2SF instructional signs.



Community Amenity/Recreation and <u>Parks</u> 1 sign proposed at each entrance to amenity properties or recreational areas.	Freestanding Signs Entrance (Monument) signs for any non- residential property or site. Size of site determines the size of sign. <3 Acres = 32SF 3-4.9 Acres = 60SF 5-9.9 Acres = 100SF 10-19.9 Acres = 150SF 20 and greater Acres = 200






= Community Monument Entry Sign*
