# THE National Community Survey™

### PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY

- Putting Residents First: Conducted in Port St. Lucie initially in 2009 and annually since 2018. Kicks off the City's annual planning process.
- Conducted by the National Research Center/Polco.
- Scientifically valid survey provides resident perceptions of a wide variety of service areas from a random sample of residents, with a corresponding open participation survey.
- Data from the survey informs the Mayor and City Council, City Manager and City Departments when prioritizing city services enhancements through the Strategic Plan, department strategic plans and ultimately the City budget.
- The City has been a prior recipient of the Voice of the People Awards, among the best of local governments that listen and take action based on resident feedback.


# HISTORY OF THE CITIZEN SUMMIT

- Launched in 2018 in response to City Council request to enhance engagement in the Strategic Plan, produced by the Communications Department and City Manager's Office and involves all departments
- Designed as a drop-in event for a "city of all ages"
- Attendance climbed to 900 residents in 2024
- Efforts to engage residents were nationally recognized with Voice of the People awards in 2019 and 2020 for transformation in foundations and transformation in Community Engagement as among the best in local government that listen and respond to the needs of residents.
