

RESOLUTION 24-R__

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE AND ST. LUCIE COUNTY EXTENDING THE TERM THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Port St. Lucie, Florida and St. Lucie County, Florida are parties to an Interlocal Agreement dated March 28, 2022, which provides a cost share between the parties for stormwater treatment area improvements in Hogpen Slough (“Interlocal Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement expired on March 28, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to renew and continue the terms of the Interlocal Agreement through an amendment which extends the term as set forth in Exhibit “A” hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PORT ST. LUCIE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Ratification of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Authorization. The Mayor or her designee, or the City Manager, or his designee, are authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, and any documents necessary to facilitate the intent of said agreement.

Section 3. Conflict. If any resolutions, or parts of resolutions, are in conflict herewith, this Resolution shall control to the extent of the conflicting provisions.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Resolution are intended to be severable. If any part of this Resolution is determined to be void or is declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
