




Opportunities to attend special events and festivals by age



Our residents want to see more special events and access to cultural offerings

Though the City continues to grow, we have identified the addition of new special events and cultural activities to be key in improving resident satisfaction. In the 2022 National Community Survey, 38% of residents positively rated overall opportunities for education, culture, and the arts and 41% of community members positively rated opportunities to attend cultural/arts/music activities, both lower than the national benchmark. Our natural environment and quality of parks and recreation opportunities scored similar to the national benchmark in the high 60th percentile. We will continue to grow resident satisfaction through investing in our parks system and natural areas and implementation of the 10-Year Parks & Recreation Master Plan and environmental lands priority projects in the Strategic Plan. In addition, we will continue to increase the number of recreational programs offered by the City, which decreased in FY 2019-2020 due to COVID-19.





The fun will only continue as we bring new parks and cultural offerings to the City this year.

The City continues to listen to residents' needs by implementing a 10-Year Parks & Recreation Master Plan to provide parks, bikeways, trails, and preserved land to the needed areas of the City. Plus, the City is advancing cultural offerings with the implementation of the Port & Pioneer Park Master Plan, Public Art Master Plan, and providing more cultural offerings/ special events.
