3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

4. ADDITIONS AND/OR DELETIONS

Chair Cox removed items P25-006, Seventh Day Adventist – Resubmittal Preliminary & Final Plat, and P25-054, McCarty – Resubmittal Preliminary Plat Construction Plans from the Agenda.

Edith Majewski **moved** to approve the amended Agenda. Kacey Cooper-Armstrong **seconded** the motion, which **passed unanimously** by voice vote.

5. PUBLIC TO BE HEARD

Chair Cox opened Public to be Heard. There being no comments, she closed Public to be Heard.

6. REVIEW OF DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

P22-143-A1 SOUTHERN GROVE – DRAGONFLY INDUSTRIAL PARK CONSTRUCTION & LANDSCAPE PLANS - PHASING

Zach Mouw, Culpepper & Terpening, represented the applicant and stated he had no questions regarding the comments.

Public Works and Utilities had no further comments to what was provided in Fusion and recommended approval with all comments to be addressed. Planner Kean stated Planning and Zoning recommended approval of this project.

Planner Robinson recommended approval with all comments to be addressed.

Edith Majewski **moved** to recommend approval of P25-099, SLW – Canopy Walk Townhomes PUD – Amendment No. 1, PUD Amendment with all comments being addressed, to the Planning and Zoning Board. Kacey Cooper-Armstrong **seconded** the motion, which **passed unanimously** by voice vote.

**P22-293 TOWN PLACE – RESIDENTIAL/RETAIL
CONSTRUCTION PLANS**

Joe Capra, CAPTEC Engineering, Inc., represented the applicant.

Planner Grubbs stated Planning and Zoning recommended tabling this project. Public Works and Utilities had no additional comments on what was provided in Fusion. With no objections, Planner Grubbs recommended approval with all comments being addressed.

Edith Majewski **moved** to approve P22-293, Town Place – Residential/Retail Construction Plans, with all comments being addressed. Kacey Cooper-Armstrong **seconded** the motion, which **passed unanimously** by voice vote.

**P20-068-A6 RIVERLAND SPORTS COMPLEX PHASE 2 MINOR SITE
PLAN AMENDMENT AND CONSTRUCTION PLANS**

Shirley Gomez, Velcon Engineering & Survey, represented the applicant and stated he received the comments.

Utilities and Public Works had no further comments on what was provided in Fusion. Planner Forman stated that Planning and Zoning recommended approval with all comments being addressed.

Edith Majewski **moved** to approve P20-068-A6, Riverland Sports Complex Phase 2 Minor Site Plan Amendment and Construction Plans, with all comments being addressed. Kacey Cooper-Armstrong **seconded** the motion, which **passed unanimously** by voice vote.

**P21-243-A1 SLW – SK CORNERSTONE, LLC – SHAKE SHACK MINOR
SITE PLAN AMENDMENT AND LANDSCAPE PLAN**

Todd Reyling, Reyling Design and Consulting, represented the applicant and

stated they received the comments.

Public Works had no further comments on what was provided in Fusion and recommended tabling this project, due to not having a traffic impact analysis or stacking queue for the drive through. Planner Da Breo-Latchman stated Planning and Zoning recommended tabling the project.

Public Works had no additional comments on what was provided in Fusion. Planner Sisk stated Planning and Zoning recommended tabling this project until the annexation agreement has been completed.
