#### **General Information**

Applicant's Request:	To provide landscaping in lieu of an architectural buffer wall on the northern portion of the property per Section 154.12 of the City of Port St. Lucie Code of Ordinances.

Property Owner:	City of Port St. Lucie
Location:	West side of SE Belvedere Street between Deacon and Thanksgiving Avenues.



# Project Summary

- The site is approximately 1.89 acres in size and is currently developed with a transit center that includes a bus shelter, bus stops for 4 buses, and associated parking.
- A Site Plan Amendment is currently in process (P11-106-A1).
- The property abuts residential development to the north and east. The community Center and other City uses are located south. A church is adjacent to the west.



#### **Modification Request**

- The applicant is requesting to provide landscaping in lieu of a wall as per Section 154.12 of the Landscape and Land Clearing Code.
- A wall is required in a landscape buffer strip where institutional or office uses abut property to the side or rear which is designated with an open space or residential land use or has a residential use per Section 154.03(C)(5) of the Landscape and Land Clearing Code.






# <u>Site Plan</u> (in process)






#### Landscape Plan (Buffer)
