Proposed Changes to Parking Code

Residential Parking

Sec. 72.01(h). - Parking prohibitions

- Define improved surfaces to allow parking in front of the home.

Commercial Vehicles

Sec. 72.03 - Parking of commercial vehicles in residential zones.

- Amend the Commercial Vehicle definition to prohibit Box Trucks.
- Add exception for Dually Truck with a standard truck bed.
- Remove Six-wheel exemption process.
- **Expand commercial vehicle exemptions to include vehicles supporting first responders and those operated by on-call personnel performing essential government functions.**

Proposed Changes to Parking Code



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Sec. 72.10 – Utility trailers in residential zones

Enclosed Utility Trailers

- Prohibit parking in the back yard, except behind a 6-ft privacy fence.
- Remove commercial lettering language.

Open Utility Trailers

- Prohibit parking in the back yard, except behind a 6-ft privacy fence.
- Mirror the size requirement to match Enclosed Utility Trailers at 20 feet in length.

Proposed Changes to Parking Code



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Sec. 72.99. – Penalty

Parking Violations

- Increase fine to:
 - \$50 all parking violations (except disabled parking)

Commercial Parking Violations

- Increase fines to:
 - \$200.00 for a first offense, \$300.00 for a second offense and \$400.00 for a third offense.
- Add language to allow violations to be brought before the Special Magistrate.
